1. Background

The International Association for Solidarity (SHIS) is an Albanian NGO founded in 1998 and officially recognized by Tirana’s Court of Justice through decision no. 2514 on 24th June, 1998. Its mission is to promote and implement development educational programs in harmony with local and national policies.

Under a tripartite consortium with *AVSI Foundation* as lead applicant and *Women in development Shkodër* as implementing partner, SHIS has currently embarked into the delivery of the project “Promoting Human rights through inclusive education and empowerment of local civil society organizations” financed by EU under the call for proposal: EuropeAid/155863/DD/ACT/AL-3 Support to Civil Society Organization Capacities



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This project aims to strengthening the role of the civil society in Albania as a driver of change for human rights protection. With e duration of 30 months, this project will be implemented in Shkodër, Pukë and Malësi e Madhe and its delivery shall entail two main pillars:

1. Promoting good models and practices for children rights protection among various stakeholders and,
2. supporting inclusive education and early childhood development on vulnerable and minority groups.

Recent assessments indicate that there is a high prevalence of violence and maltreatment in the homes, schools, and institutions in Albania. Studies also indicate that the use of violence against children is widely accepted and even deemed to have positive effects on a child's education and development.

During the first year it is foreseen the delivery of a **survey on the situation of violence and bullying among 12 compulsory schools in north Albania**. The aim of the study, will be to present a detailed picture of the extent, nature and causes of violence and abuse against children and to develop recommendations for action. This activity will create a baseline of the situation of violence and abuse against children in Albania, by sampling 12 elementary schools in the areas of Shkodra, Puka and Malesia e Madhe.

Hence, the Project is announcing a **Call for a Pedagogical Advisor** for a team of experts to carry out a **Baseline Survey** on children's rights in Albania

2. Purpose of the assignment and scope of work

The **Pedagogical Advisor** have the role of helping the team to understand different perspective of the children's development, in order to reach in an accurate way the survey goal.



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Pedagogical Advisor duties and responsibilities:

- The pedagogical advisor will be responsible for bringing information from different point of view, always remembering the best guarantee for children's rights.
- The Advisor will be involved in three phases of the project: design of the research methodology, analysis of the data, and commenting the final reports

3. Required Skills and Experience

- Have a university degree in social sciences/psychology/education
- Have significant experience in the field of human right and especially working with issues regarding children's right in Albania
- Minimum of 5 years of experience in a civil society/or education sector in Albania
- Demonstrable organizational, communication, analytical and interpersonal skills
- Knowledge of English language is preferred.

4. Output/Deliverables

The following will be the expected deliverables

- Revision and recommendation on the Baseline study approach
- Recommendation on the Baseline final report

5. Duration of Assignment

The **Pedagogical Advisor** will be engaged from September 2018 to May 2019 with daily fees payments.

6. Remuneration



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The payment will be discussed, during the signature of the contract with the successful candidate. SHIS will be hold from the remuneration corresponding amount of tax at source in accordance with the Albanian legislation in force (15% of total gross amount for payment)
